Hello Partners and Friends, grace, peace, and favor to you. Happy New Year. We hope you all had a marvelous Christmas and Holi-day season and are ready for a new year of glory. I was fasting and praying in October and sensed in my spirit to ask, "Lord, what about 2024?" I immediately heard the Lord say:

There is going to be more. More of My glory, more of My goodness for those who seek Me.

I also quickly got the sense it will not be that way for those who do not.

I am reminded of Romans 2:4 (NKJV), 'Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?' There are many movies and shows that portray God as an angry God. However, we see repeatedly in the Word of God how merciful and good God is. Our Heavenly Father is loving and kind. Sure, He hates sin. He hates evil because He knows is destroys lives and steals from the goodness His Son died and paid the price for.

He wants us to run to Him and not away from Him when we mess up. He wants us to come to Him so He can help us make things right. How do we do that? Saturate yourself in the Word of God through reading your Bible. Billy Graham said, "If you are ignorant of God's Word, you will always be ignorant of God's will."¹ We have it so easy today. We can carry our Bibles on our phones, get daily scripture reminders, and read throughout the day when we need some encouragement. Keeping our eyes on His Promises is how we will keep our hearts from being troubled in a clearly troubled world.
